Microsoft Strikes Record **Carbon Removal Deal**



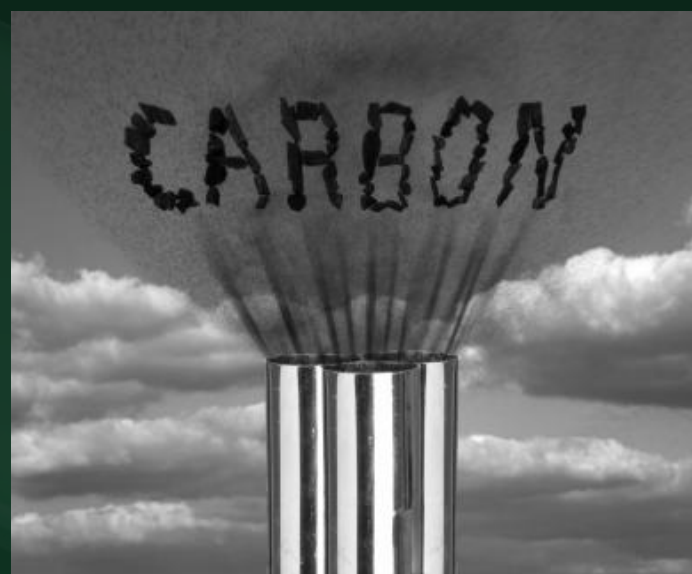
Commits to buy

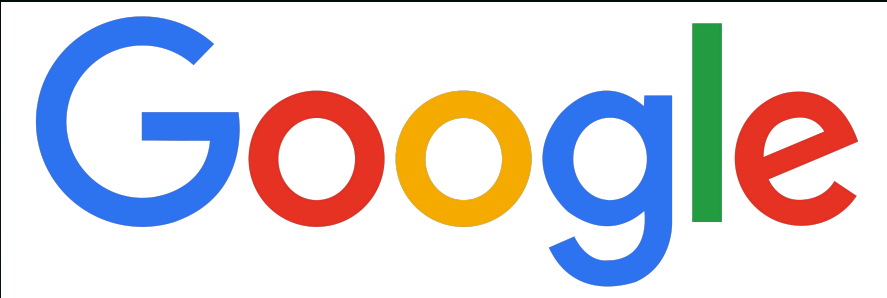

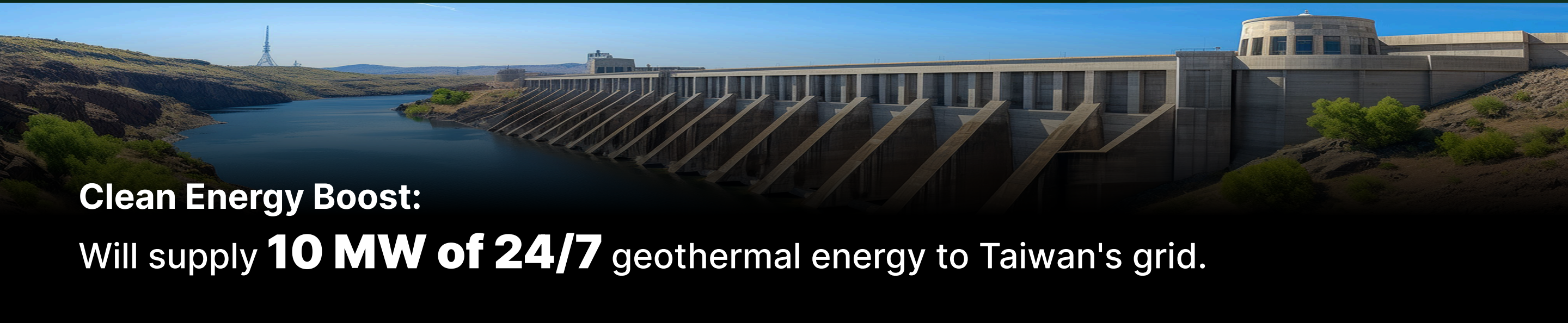

Google Inks First Geothermal Energy Deal in Asia to Power Taiwan



Milestone PPA:
Google signs its first geothermal power purchase agreement (PPA) in Asia with Baseload Capital.

First for Taiwan	Marks Taiwan’s first-ever corporate geothermal deal, nearly doubling current capacity.
Regional Strategy	Key step in Google’s broader clean energy transition across Asia.

LEGO to Build \$1B Solar-Powered Factory in Vietnam by 2026

\$1B investment in a solar-powered manufacturing plant in Vietnam, set to be operational by early 2026.



Will run on **100%** renewable energy, featuring **12,400** rooftop solar panels and a new energy center with large-scale battery storage.



First LEGO facility to achieve LEED Platinum certification for key areas; others rated LEED Gold.

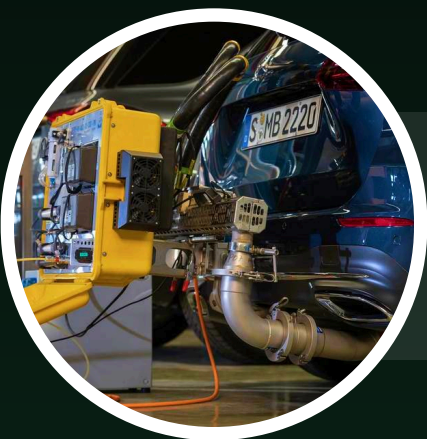
