TotalEnergies Acquires 350 MW Solar Portfolio from Low Carbon

Low Carbon sold 8 ready-to-build solar projects **(350 MW)** and 2 battery storage assets **(85 MW)** to TotalEnergies.



Projects are part of Low Carbon's **16 GW** renewable pipeline.



Expected to be operational by 2028, generating **350+** GWh/year.

DuPont Hits 100% Renewable Electricity in EU Facilities

All DuPont EU sites now run on **100%** renewable electricity.

\$4M investment to cover **20,000** acres, aiming to save **500M** gallons of water over 8 years.

Part of Google's **2030** water positivity goal — to replenish **120%** of its freshwater use.

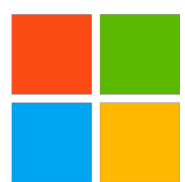
Indigo Ag & Microsoft **Expand Carbon Removal Deal**



Microsoft to buy **60,000** soil carbon credits from U.S. farmers practicing regenerative agriculture.



This follows last year's purchase of **40,000** carbon credits in a continuing partnership.
